**IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMISSION OF ONLINE APPLICATION
(UPTO 2.30 PM BY 30.08.2016) FOR ADMISSION TO MBBS COURSE
2016-17 FOR NRI 15% SEATS.**

- 1 Application for admission is to be submitted on prescribed Proforma online using the University website www.mmusolan.org alongwith all required documents/certificates and processing fee i.e. 100US \$ or equivalent in rupees in shape of Bank Draft drawn in favour of Registrar, M.M. University, Kumarhatti-Solan payable at Solan by 30.8.2016.
- 2 The candidates have to produce all the original documents including Matric and +2 Certificates at the time of counselling along with their attested copies, NEET-2016 admit card, Rank Card and ID Proof, Valid Passport/ Visa and equivalent certificate issued by AIU, New Delhi if qualifying examination passed other than Indian Board/ University.
- 3 All the admissions will be provisional i.e. subject to their final registration with the M.M. University after completing necessary requirements as per rules/ordinance of the University.
- 4 The University has the right to change the dates of admission process/Counselling on account of some unavoidable circumstances.
- 5 The selection for admission will be treated as cancelled, if the selected candidate does not join the Institute on the stipulated date fixed by the Counselling Board.
- 6 Undertaking against ragging (to be submitted at the time of counselling). Migration Certificate can be submitted within 15 days of admission.
- 7 The University has appointed the following Grievance Committee, which will examine/decide objections, if any, received from the candidates appeared in the Counselling within 48 hours from the date of counselling:
 - i. Shri Ajay Singal, Registrar, MM University, Kumarhatti-Solan.
 - ii. Dr.J.S. Sandhu, Associate Professor, MM Medical College & Hospital, MMU Kumarhatti-Solan.

8. Subject to availability of hostel accommodation on first come first served basis, every student admitted to the course will have to reside in the Hostel of the Institute for which hostel charges will be extra.

9. Duration of the Course

- (i) MBBS course is of four and a half years duration followed by compulsory rotatory internship of one year.

10. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

- i. The Candidate should have fulfilled eligibility conditions as mentioned in the Prospectus of NEET-I/NEET-II-2016 issued by CBSE.
- ii. The candidate will attain the age of 17 year or more on 31.12.2016.
- iii. The must have passed the Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2) of Board of School Education, Himachal Pradesh or an examination as equivalent thereto with five subjects from any recognized Board/University with atleast 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology taken together and must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology and English individually in the qualifying examination.
- iv. The Candidate should NRI or Son/Daughter/Ward of NRI, An affidavit to be submitted by the parents/relatives of the candidate mentioning relation with the candidate and under taking for payment of fees in this regard alongwith the application.
- v. The Candidate who have passed the qualifying examination (10+2) or equivalent examination) from other than Indian Board have to submit the equivalence certificate issued by AIU, New Delhi.

11. METHOD OF SELECTION AND ADMISSION:

The admission to MBBS course will be made on the basis of all India merit of NEET-I/NEET-II-2016.

(I) Counselling:

The schedule of counselling will be notified on the website of the University separately.

(II) METHOD OF ADMISSION:

- (i) The candidates will be required to exercise for opt the seat for the course at the time of counselling. The allotment of the seats shall be made according to merit at the time of Counselling. If a candidate opts for a course and Institution before the counselling Board and fails to join the concerned course/college, his/her candidature will stand cancelled and such candidate will not be allowed to exercise his/her option at the next counselling.
- (ii) The candidates who fail to attend the Medical Examination of the notified date(s) will forfeit the claim for admission and placement in the waiting list in order of merit.
- (iii) As decided by the Medical Council of India in terms of decision of the

12. FEE STRUCTURE-2016-17

Name of the Course	Tuition Fee for full course
MBBS	USD 1.20 Lac for full course per student + 5% Development charges per annum (on amount of annual fee not on full course fees)

NOTE:

1. The above rates of fee for MBBS are excluding one time. Registration fee, University charges.
2. Fees will have to deposit at the time of counselling.
3. Selected candidates will have to execute a bond to the effect that they shall be liable to pay the total fee of the full course. The text of the bond to be executed can be obtained from the Admission office of the University.
4. The students, who will not be able to complete the course within the stipulated period, will have to pay additional fee for each extended period.
5. In case any candidate after getting admission wants leaves the course he/she will have to pay fee as applicable for the full course.
